- Judi Frost: Can 'work trip grant' (disaster volunteering grant) funds be used to encourage immersion trips or trips to/with sustainable development partners?
- Andy Mangum: Do we need to have the Board and John Goebel create a policy about what percentage of investments go to DCEF and to CCF, to have certain monies readily available for emergency responses and grant applications/capacity? Can be targets with some flexibility. Should we consider establishing a finance committee? Policy/Recommendation by next Board meeting.
