Hurricane Harvey	Texas	Aug 2017	Continued support for home repair and rebuild through Galveston County Recovers and Wharton West End Initiative, with a new partnership in Refugio County with MDS and the Coastal Bend Disaster Recovery Group.
Hurricane Irma	Florida	Sept 2017	Continued support for home repair and rebuild through VIND (housed at FCC Daytona), with new grants and partnerships developing in several additional counties as they exhaust their early funding sources.
Carr Fire	Shasta County, CA	Aug 2018	Continued support through FCC Redding.
Hurricanes Irma and Maria	Puerto Rico	Sept 2017	Programa Edefiquemos shifted to include additional support for repair of church buildings, and has increased the use of contract labor due to COVID-19 (contracted crews were supplementing volunteer teams).
Hurricane Florence	North Carolina	Sept 2018	Primary partnership is still with Pamlico County DRC, with grant support and volunteer housing at Camp Caroline
Hurricane Michael	Florida	Oct 2018	Several new LTRG partnerships are in development
Camp Fire	Butte County, CA	Nov 2018	Ongoing conversation about possible grant support for housing solutions through the LTRG (Camp Fire Collaborative); renewed support of Resilience Resources after organizational restructuring
Tornadoes	Miami Valley (Dayton), OH	May 2019	Developing collaboration with BDM, UCC, the Miami Valley LTRG, and several local orgs to implement a new homeownership program for displaced renters
Flooding and Tornadoes	El Reno, OK	May 2019	Volunteer support on hold; ongoing conversation with FCC El Reno
Tropical Storm Imelda	Texas	Sept 2019	Current partnership with Habitat for Humanity concluding; exploring ongoing support for recovery
Flooding	Oregon	Feb 2020	Exploring potential long-term recovery support
Tornadoes	Tennessee	Mar/Apr 2020	Continuing conversation with Disciples in Nashville and Chattanooga an TN VOAD
